Greece




Between 2009 and 2012, Greece's fiscal deficit was reduced from **15.6% to 9.6% of GDP**, the second highest improvement across the OECD.

## Did you know?

With less than **8%** of the labour force employed by the government, Greece has one of the smallest government workforces among OECD countries. Between 2007 and 2012, confidence in government in Greece decreased from **38% to 13%**, the second strongest decrease within the OECD.



Education: performance in PISA reading scores and expenditure per student (aged 6 to 15) in USD PPP (2009) PISA Reading Score




Impact of the tax system and grants on reducing income inequality

#### **Fiscal sustainability**


Total consolidation requirements between 2012 and 2030 in order to reduce government debt to 60% of GDP










#### Structure of government expenditures (2011)






